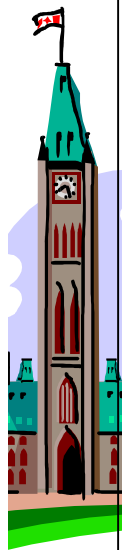
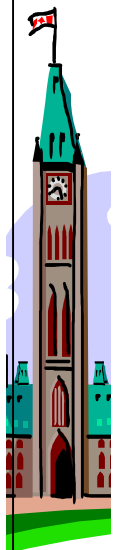

For each backpack you fill for your child, commit to filling another for a child in the same grade!

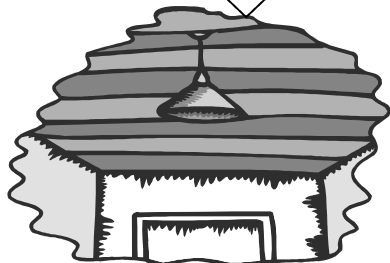

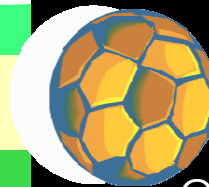
